"EMBOSSED URN"

Artist Statement:

"There seems to be endless possibilities when creating with clay. With this urn I embossed the surface by first sketching my design on the dried form. Next I painted shellac over the design. Leaving the shellac to dry completely, I then damp sponged the entire urn several times over. The embossing forms by the clay being washed away around the hardened shellac. I like the subtle effect of this technique."






