Roles and Responsibilities of Regional Arts Councils Approved at the *Assembly of BC Arts Councils AGM, October 1, 1993

*Assembly of BC Arts Councils changed its name to Arts BC in March, 2011

Communication

- 1. To create and maintain partnerships with regional partners (districts, boards, associations and regional representatives from other provincial arts and tourism organizations)
- 2. To create regional forums for the collection, analysis, compilation and dissemination of information
- 3. To establish opportunities for contact among arts councils in the region, with individual arts councils in the region, Arts BC and the BC Arts Council
- 4. To provide artists and community members opportunities for interaction at a regional level.
- 5. To create forums for regional dialogue

Training

- 1. To provide opportunities for management and board development
- 2. To empower CACs within the region
- 3. To broaden the leadership base regionally
- 4. To model inclusive leadership practices regionally
- 5. To increase knowledge of the regional cultural context and issues
- 6. To increase knowledge of equity issues as they pertain to regional cultural activities
- 7. To provide a regional historical perspective

Advocacy

- 1. To establish and maintain relationships with regional government officials and to keep them informed on arts issues within the region
- 2. To engender regional development through the linking of communities within the region
- 3. To provide opportunities for the support, presentation and consultation of historians and practicing artists in all the creative disciplines within the region
- 4. To bring together creative practitioners that might not otherwise meet through initiating regional development projects and programs
- 5. To participate in provincial arts advocacy issues
- 6. To generate regional arts advocacy issues
- 7. To ensure equity of access to all regional programs
