



LEADERSHIP GRANT REGULATIONS AND PROCEDURES
PEACE LIARD REGIONAL ARTS COUNCIL

INTENT

To encourage the development of knowledge and expertise of Community Arts Council members, the PLRAC provides an annual grant of \$400 to be used for payment of expenses incurred attending workshops in Board Development or other topics leading to increased implementation of their constitutional goals and objectives.

REGULATIONS

1. Each Community Arts Council that is a member of the PLRAC is eligible for this grant.
2. Application on the appropriate form must be received by the Treasurer of the PLRAC by November 30 of each year.

PROCEDURES

1. The Community Arts Council must complete the application and forward it to the PLRAC Treasurer.
2. The Treasurer will present the application at the Annual General Meeting of the Board for approval.
3. Following approval, the Treasurer will issue a cheque to the Community Arts Council.
