



PLRAC Regional Development Grant Application

Purpose of Regional Development Grants

The purpose of the PLRAC is to broaden opportunities for the development of and networking in arts, culture and heritage for the people of northeast BC. To qualify for a Regional Development Grant the event or project must be:

- a. Regional in scope
- b. Open to participants and/or artists from the region
- c. Have significant regional impact with long lasting benefits to arts, culture and heritage within the region

Guidelines for Application

Eligibility:

To qualify for a Regional Development Grant the organization must have at least one of the following five criteria:

- a. Is a member of a Community Arts Council in the Peace Liard Region
- b. Have a financial statement for the previous year
- c. Have a sound financial history
- d. Have a membership base and/or an Executive of at least three individuals
- e. Be a regional group representing a provincial organization (e.g. Theatre BC)

Grant Amount Available:

Regional Development Grants are \$500 each with the total amount depending on the availability of funds.

Assessment Criteria

The committee will base its decision on the assessment criteria listed below:

- 1) A clear objective
- 2) Evidence of the applicant's ability to carry out the project, as demonstrated by their resources, expertise, and past performance
- 3) A detailed list of activities planned
- 4) A clear intended outcome, indicating the contribution the project will make to the community
- 5) A detailed budget defining expenditures and other funding sources (demonstration that the applicant has sought additional sources of funding is encouraged)

Acknowledgement of PLRAC Support

The Peace Liard Regional Arts Council appreciates the use of its logo in all promotional material and in publications and programs associated with the grant. A logo will be provided to the applicant upon approval of a grant.

Final Report
